




Our priorities for 2015 are:

4 main improvements we've been working on:

- 1. technical
- 2. refining the rules
- 3. more data & methods
- 4. more identity providers

1. Technical and user journey

More than 100 incremental changes on the hub and certified companies

Examples of improvements

- improving SMS delivery speed
- making it easier for people to recover from a fraud flag
- allowing people to use driver licences and passports within 6 months of expiry
- Improving the credit card questions
- Passport check accuracy
- Longer session expiry times to allow more time for users to match
- improved matching speed




