of public services available online. The move has prompted privacy concerns. Government aides insist that, far from bringing in identity cards by the back door, the new voluntary scheme makes any attempt to reintroduce a compulsory document much less likely.

"This removal is and for all the need for an identity card because it will be possible to prove your identity securely without one," a source said.

Under the Verity programme, people choose one of five private providers — including Experian and the Post Office — to complete an online security check. This will give them a username and password, and send a code to their mobile phones which will allow them to use a range of government services.

Driving licences and assessment tax returns are the first facilities to be rolled out. It will take months to roll out other services.

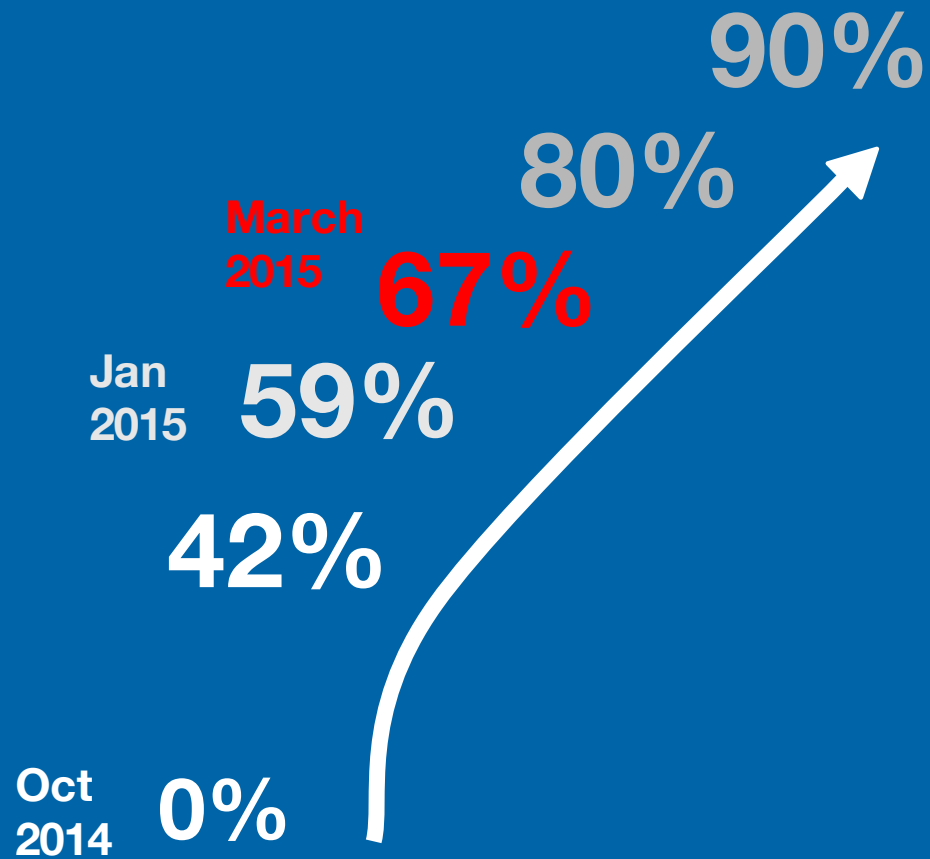

4 main improvements we've been working on:

1. technical
2. refining the rules
3. more data & methods
4. more identity providers

1. Technical and user journey

More than 100 incremental changes
on the hub and certified companies

Examples of improvements

- improving SMS delivery speed
- making it easier for people to recover from a fraud flag
- allowing people to use driver licences and passports within 6 months of expiry
- Improving the credit card questions
- Passport check accuracy
- Longer session expiry times to allow more time for users to match
- improved matching speed

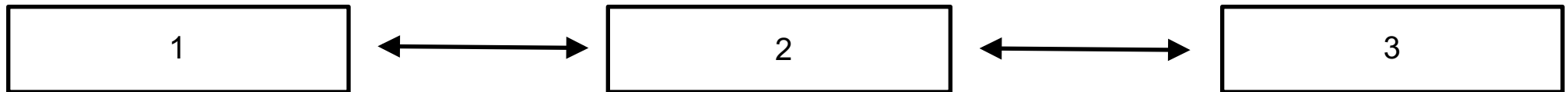

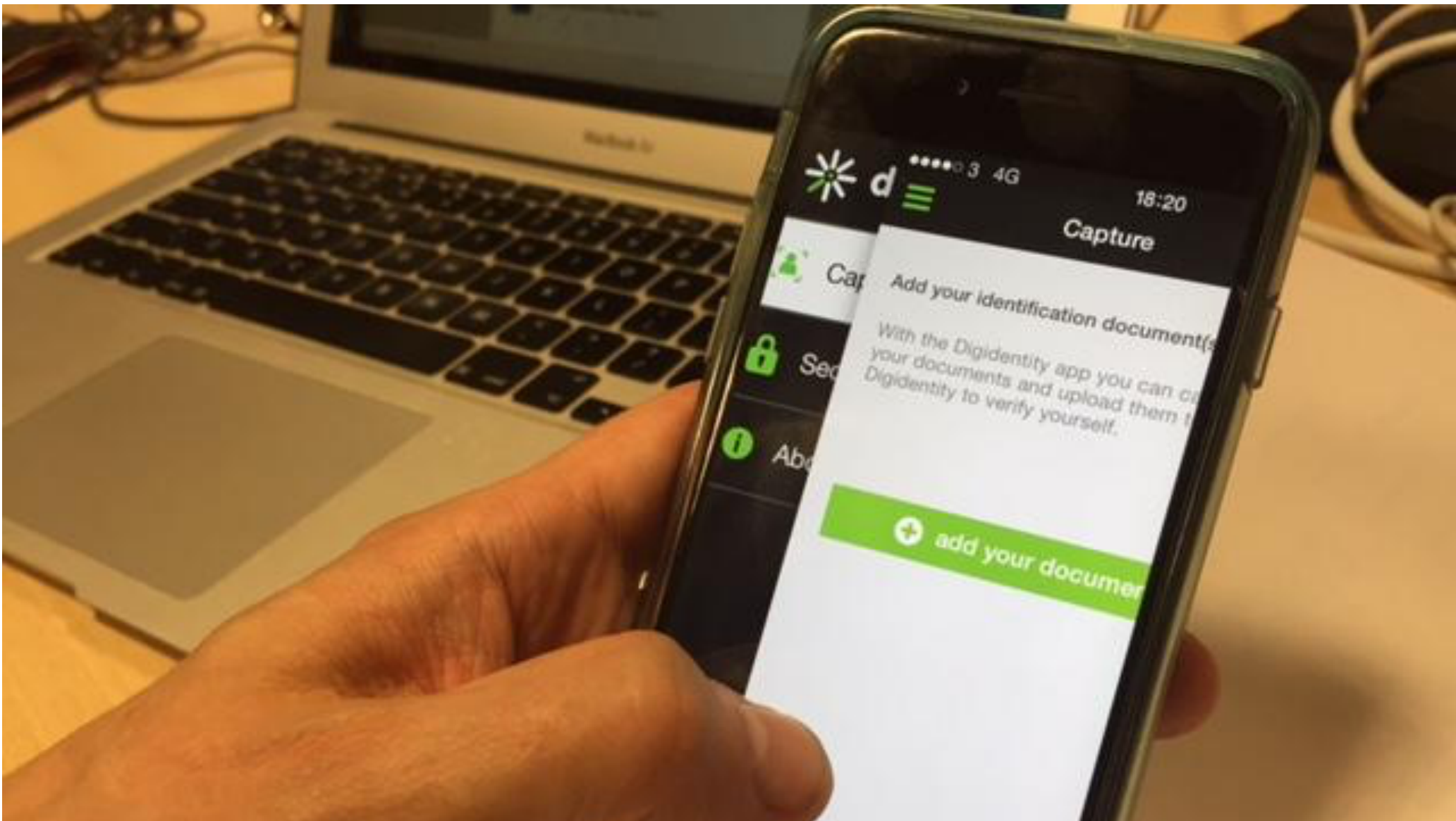
